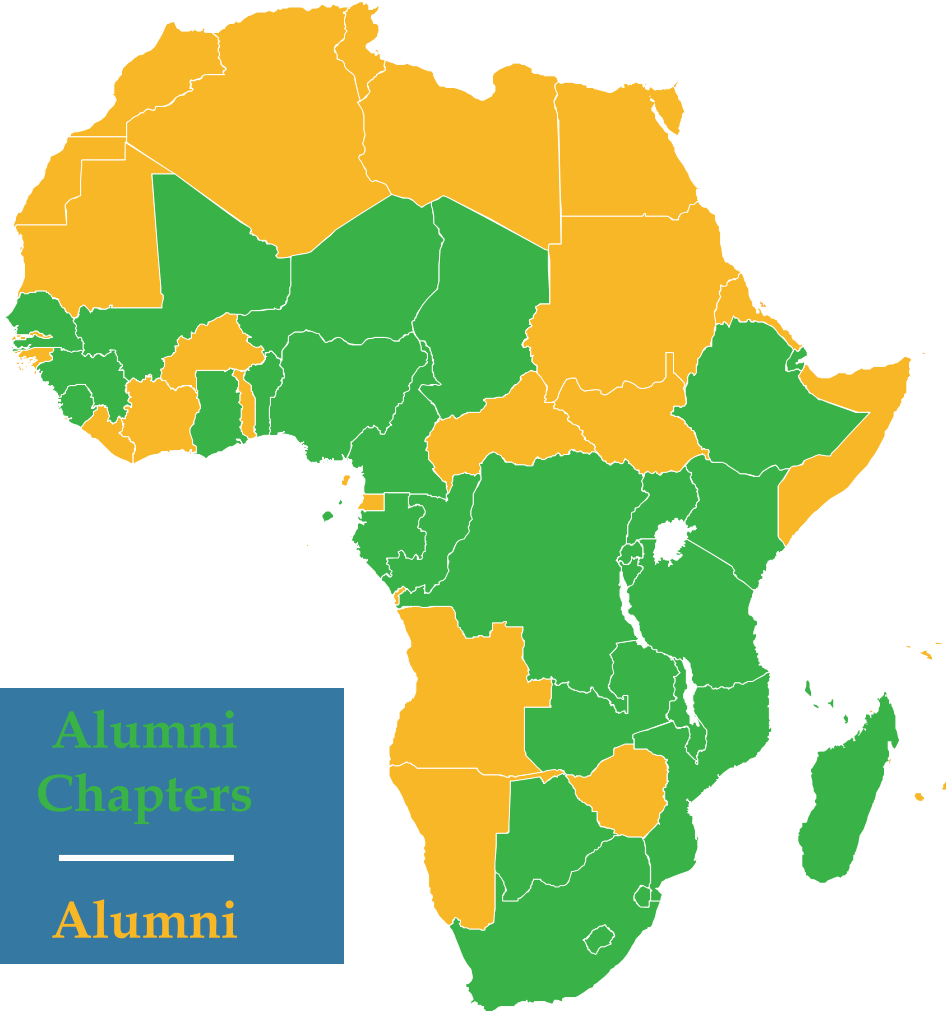

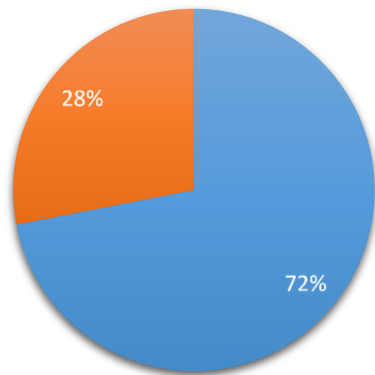

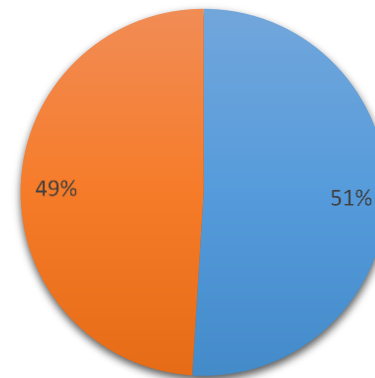

### Gender Breakdown



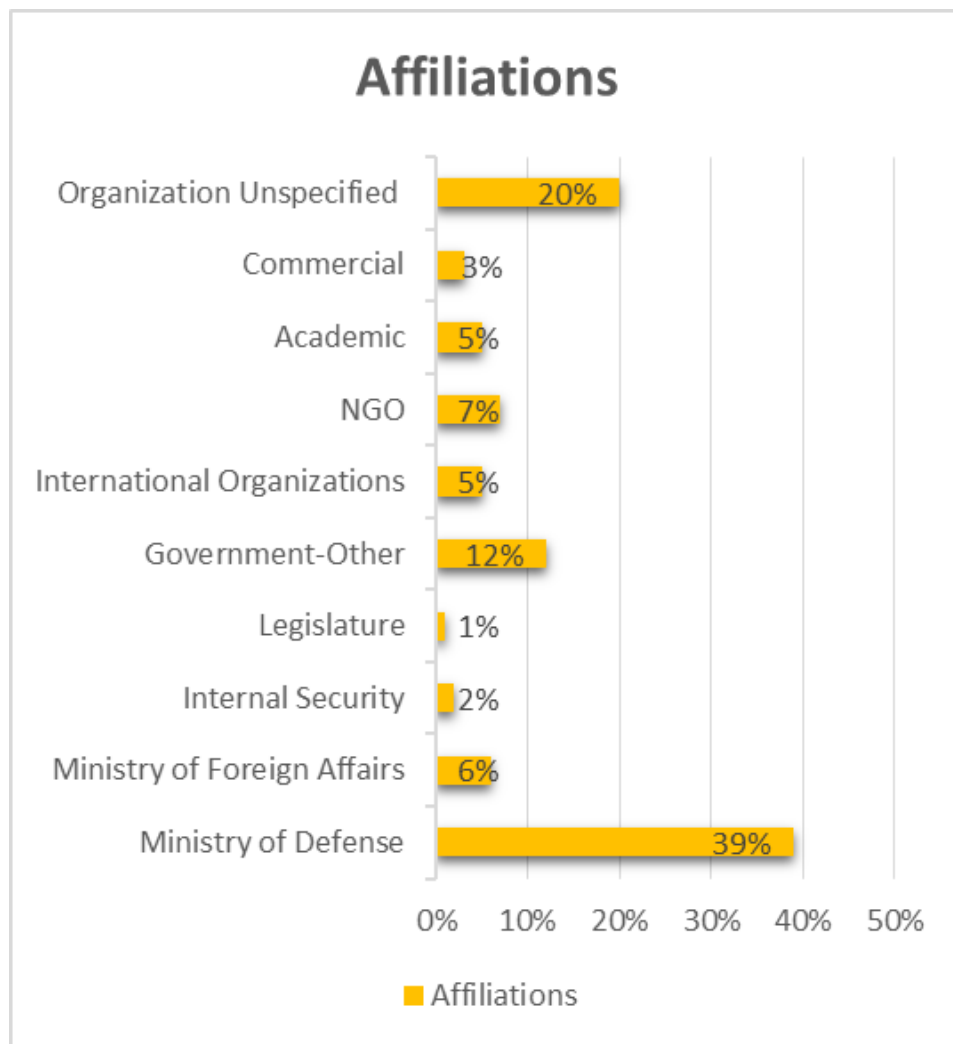

### Military vs. Civilian



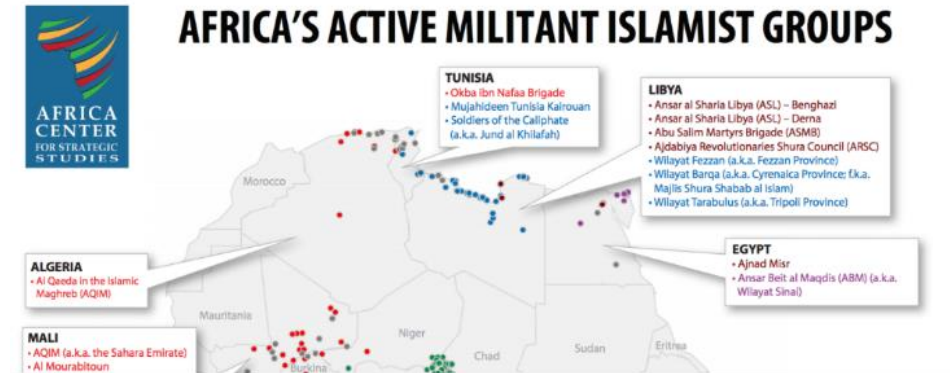

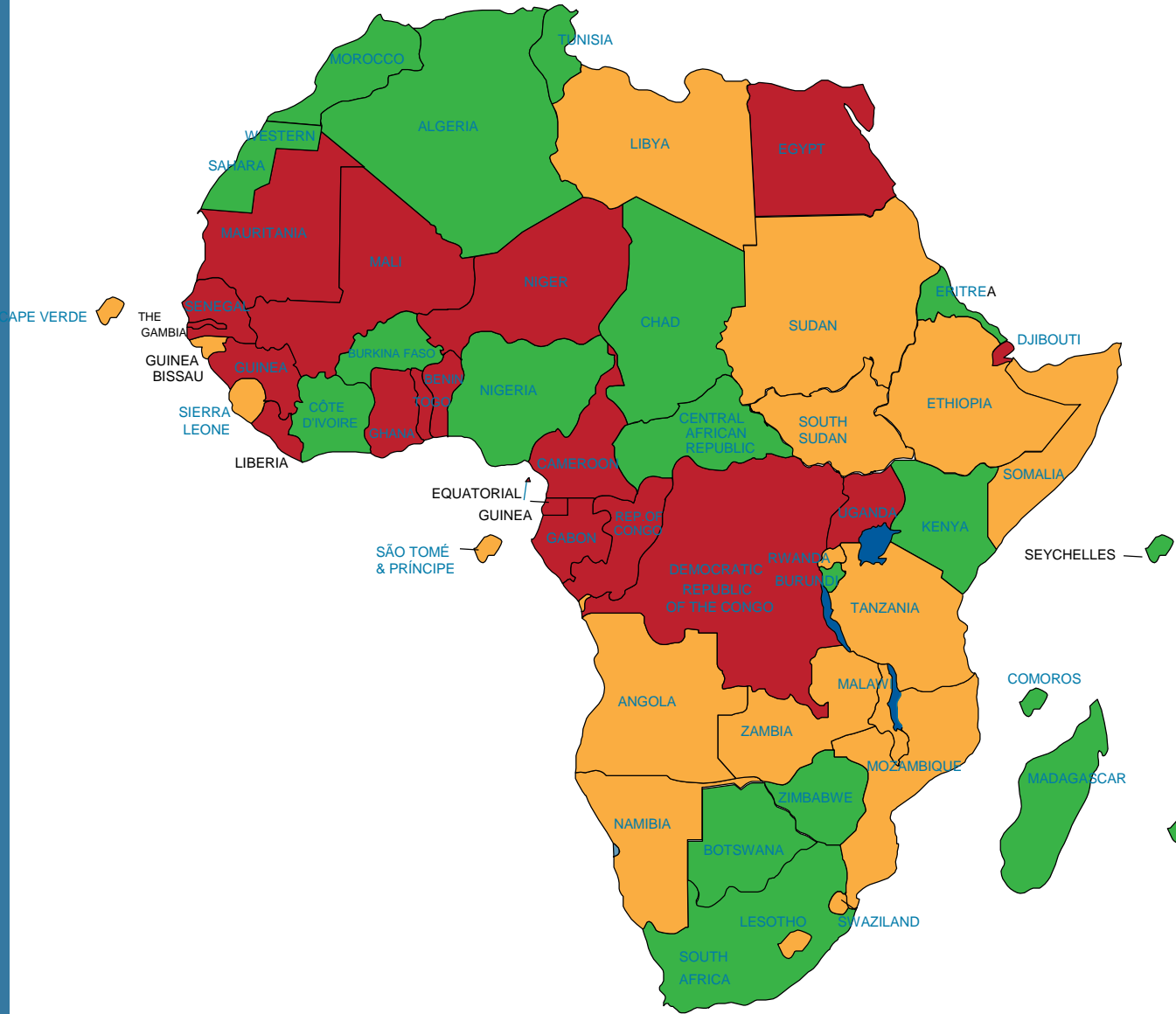
