
### NATIONAL SECURITY STRATEGY

The national security strategy's primary objective is to avert risks and threats that may affect the country's very existence. It is a document or a series of documents (defense policy, white paper, national domestic security strategy) describing the requirements for the implementation of a national security policy.

### **NATIONAL SECURITY POLICY**

The national security policy provides a general description of security priorities and objectives, while the security strategy describes how these objectives may be achieved through the use of a government's power apparatus.
