The crisis of piracy: the trigger

► Advances

- Doctrinal and Operational Axis (Code of Djibouti. BMP,...)
- Capability Axis (deployment of forces, strengthening of the Civilian capabilities, Training/Formation)
- Dialog Axis (Inter-state forums, Platforms for dialog, Communication tools...)
- Judicial Axis (Accords, ONUDC...)



Beyond the fight against Piracy

- ▶ **Limitations of the existing architecture**

- ▶ Maritime Security = Global Phenomenon
- ▶ Multiplicity of actors
- ▶ Initiatives = external to the area

- ▶ **MASE Ideology**
