 - Maritime security and facilitation to underpin development of maritime sector and "blue economy"







Jeddah Amendment to the Djibouti Code of Conduct

"The Revised Code of conduct concerning the repression of piracy, armed robbery against ships and illicit maritime activity in the western Indian Ocean and the Gulf of Aden area"



Code of Conduct for west and central Africa

"Code of conduct concerning the repression of piracy, armed robbery against ships and illicit maritime activity in west and central Africa"

 Adopted by 25 States in Yaoundé, Cameroon, in 2013





Developing maritime security issues

- Cyber security
 - Building on IMO and industry guidance
 - MSC-FAL.1/Circ.3 on Guidelines on maritime cyber risk management
 - Resolution MSC.428(98) on Maritime cyber risk management in safety management systems
- Autonomous ships
 - How to regulate ships that are operated from ashore?
- Floating armouries
 - If not wholly a flag State issue, demonstration of a compelling need to IMO to develop guidance
- ISPS Code for the energy sector
 - Best practice for production, storage, and transport systems
