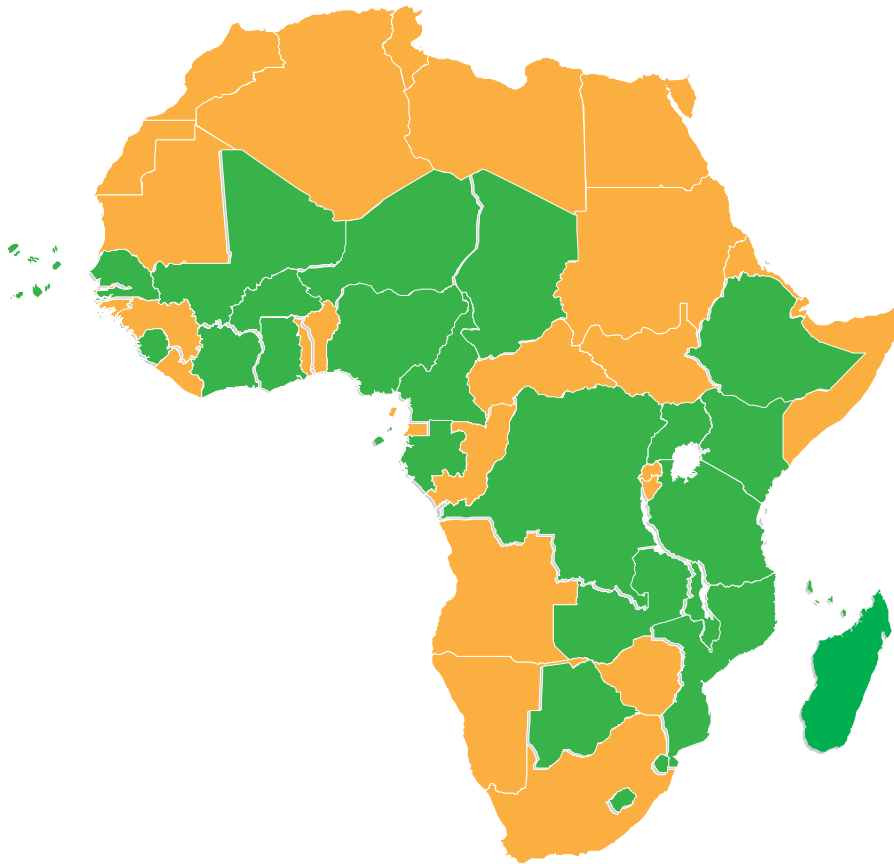
Alumni Network

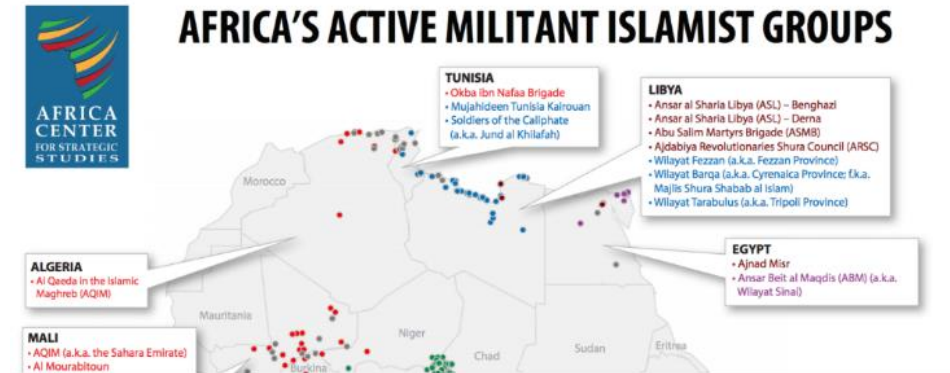

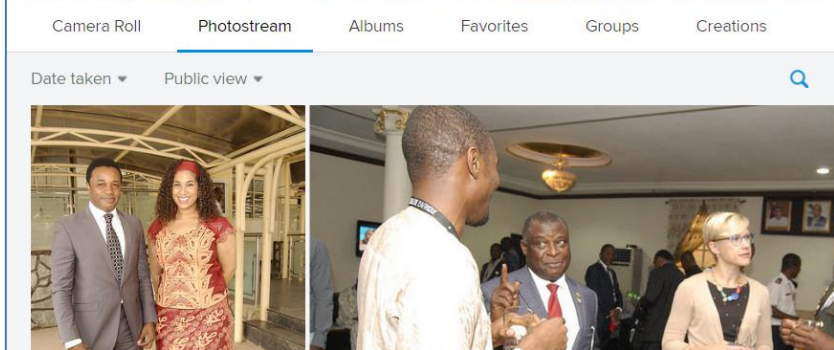

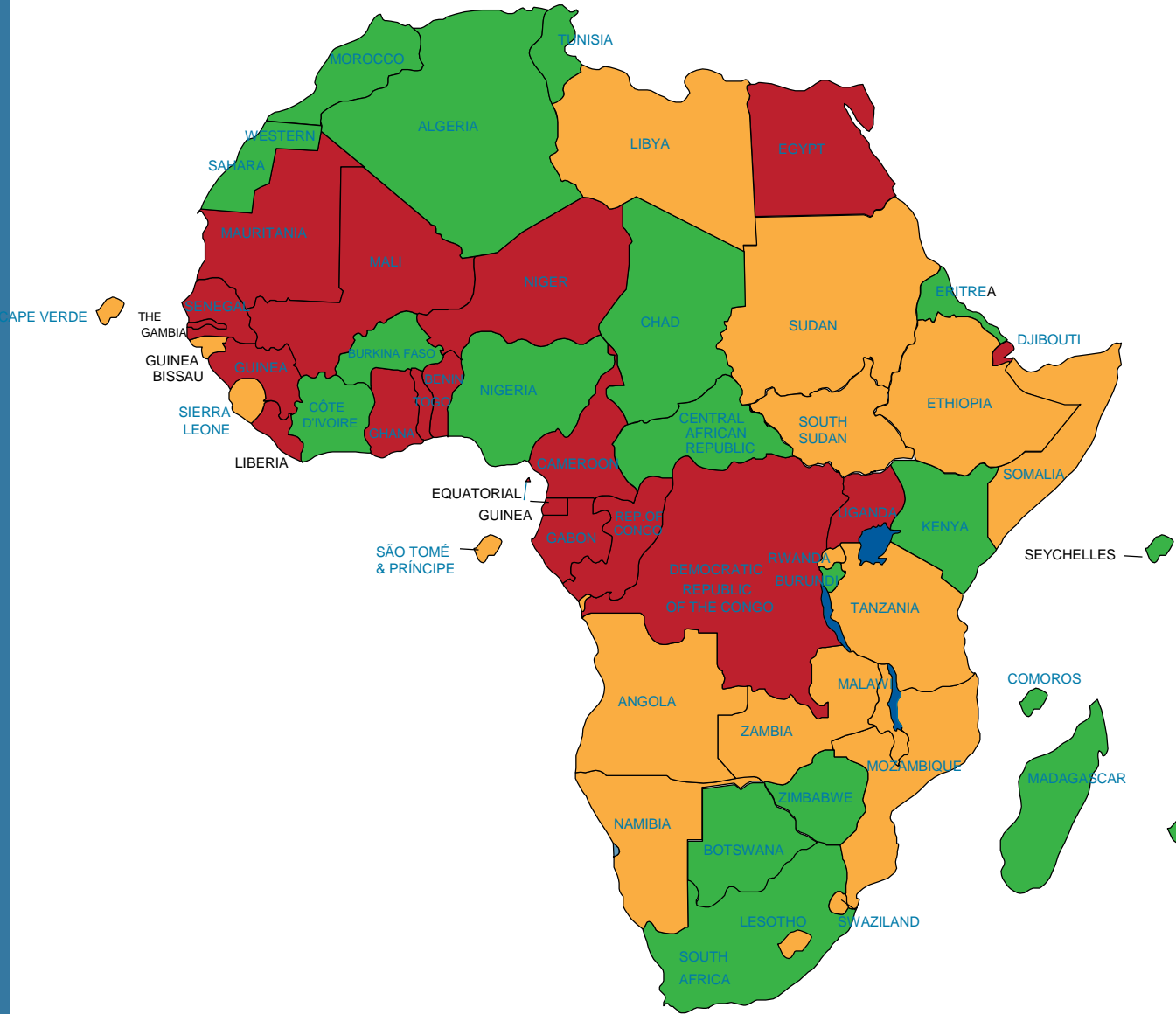
