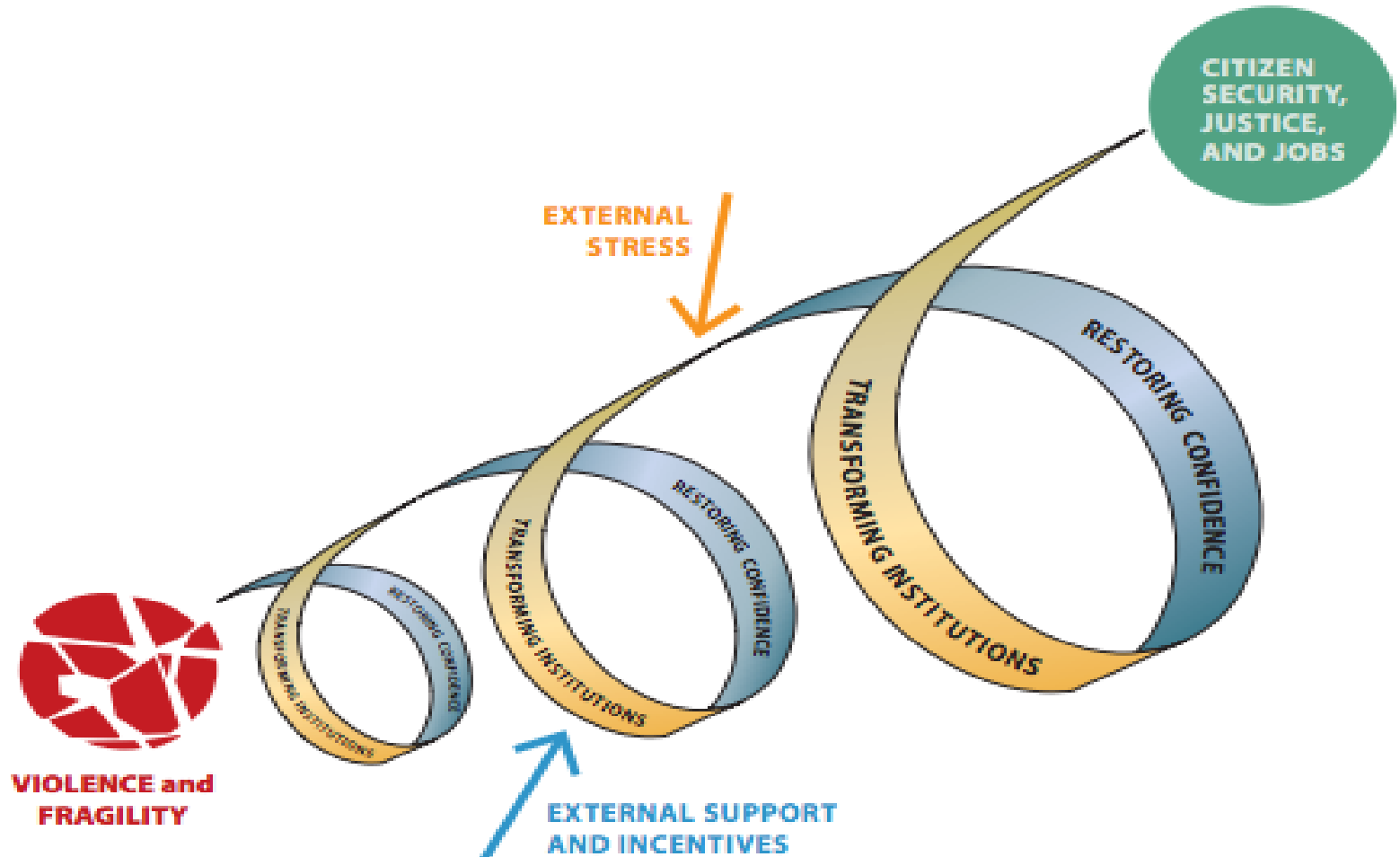

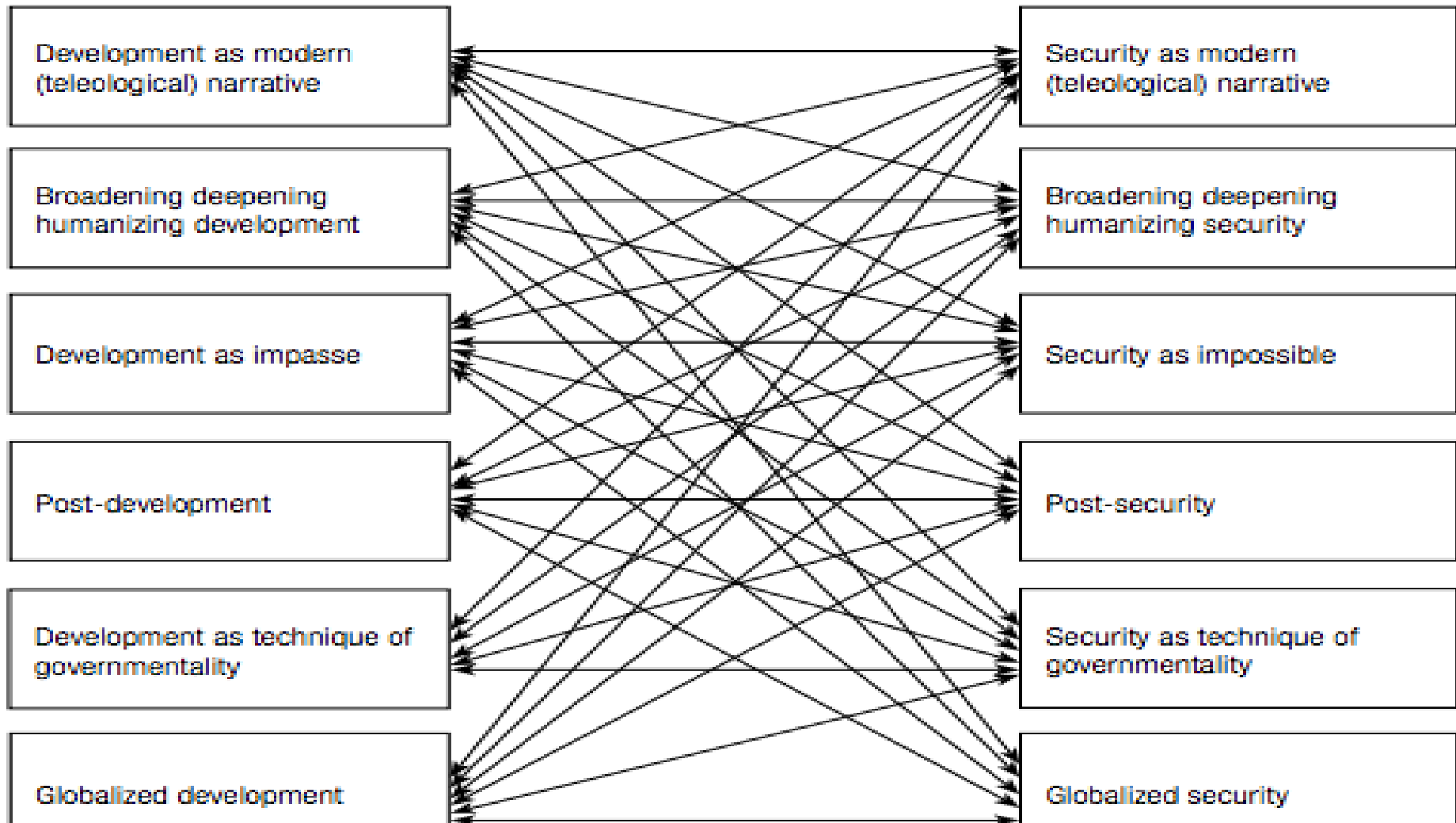


Development-Security-Justice Nexus

The Challenges: Mapping the Nexus

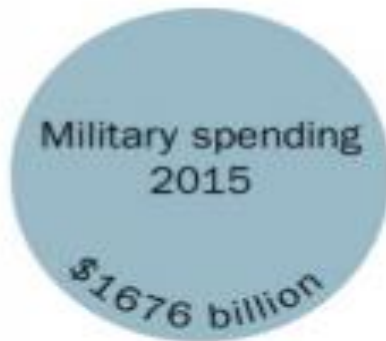

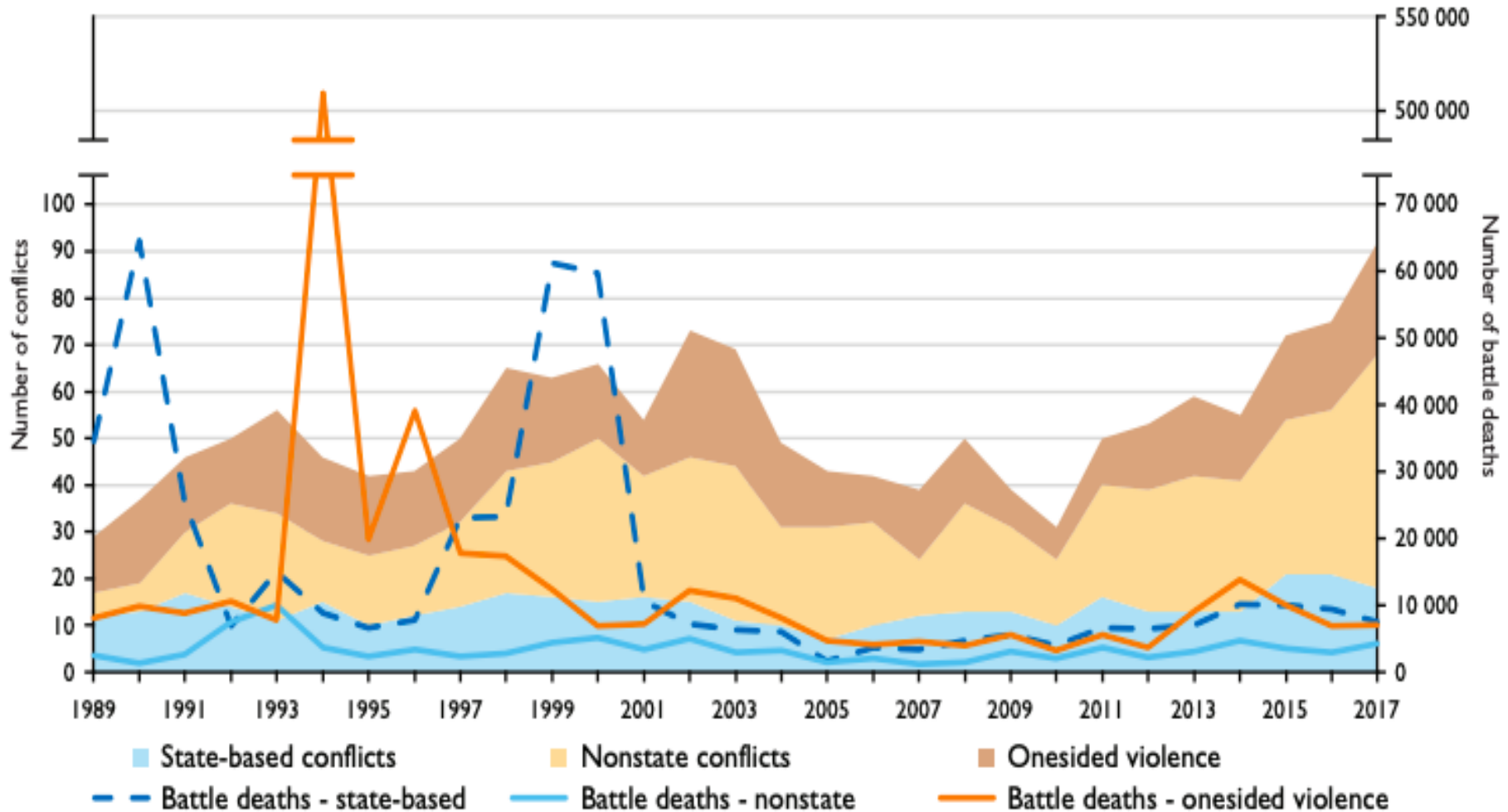

The Nature of Security Threats in Africa



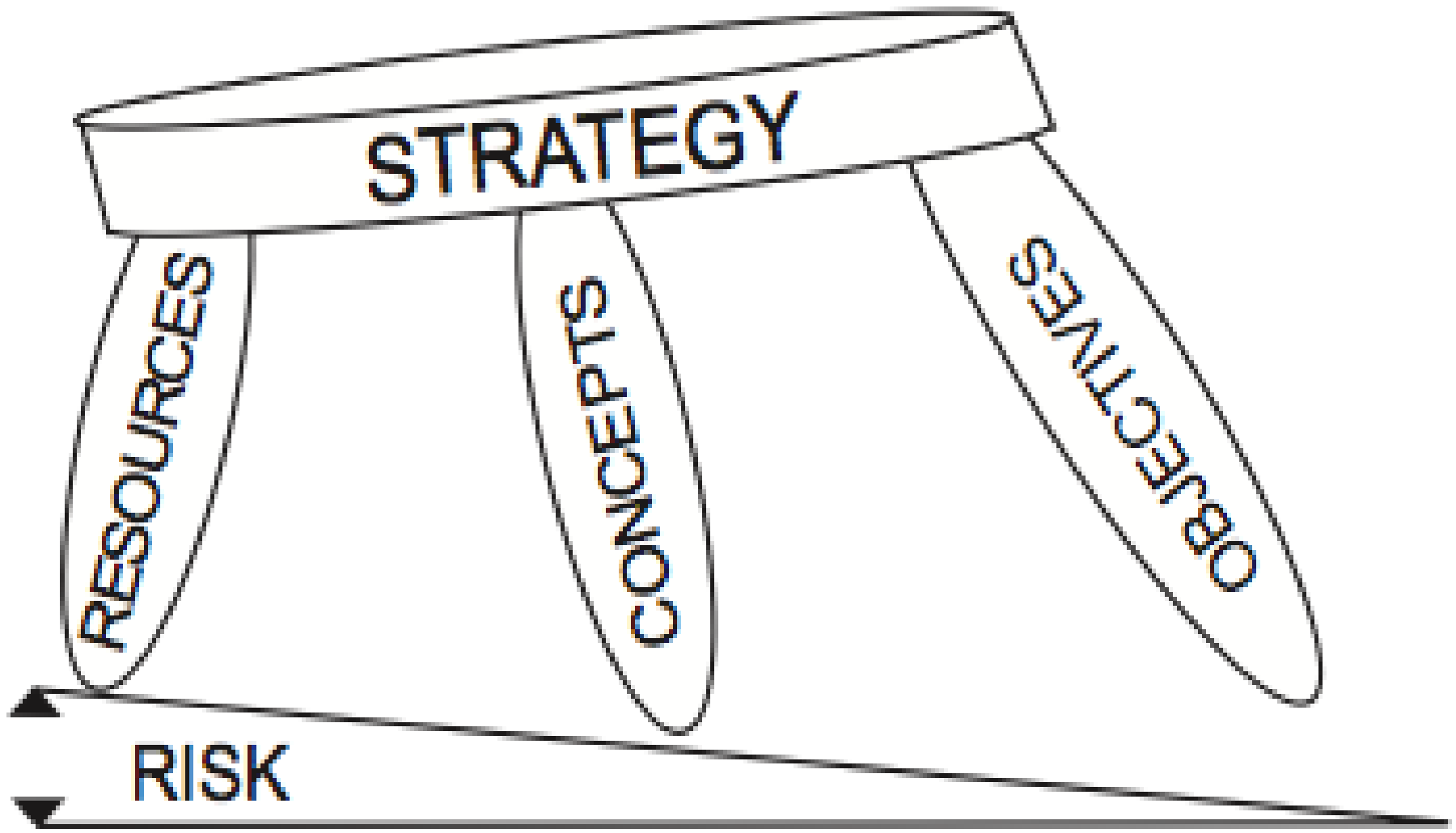
