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Introduction

- The fight against violent extremism is an asymmetrical war that no state, regardless of its power, can win alone: The enemy is faceless.
- Its sole objective is to dissolve social bonds
- It calls for frameworks, mechanisms, operations and training programs that promote and support cooperation between security forces and local communities.

Introduction (suite)

- Unfortunately, for many years, the security forces have distinguished themselves by contempt, violence and racketeering directed at the population.
- Finding: Civil-security relations will need to be cleaned up to rebuild mutual trust and respect between the people and their security forces.
- Côte d'Ivoire, which has taken the full measure of this situation, has implemented a national security strategy based on human security and community policing as essential tools for the prevention and fight against violent extremism.







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



Restitutions Denonciations




This graph reflects the strong variations between the level of cooperation of populations with the police and the level of

.The lower the denunciations, the higher the infractions.


