


NATIONAL SECURITY

- Military and non-military threats likely to affect the nation
- Protection of the population, territorial integrity, continuity of institutions
- Securing the nation (conventional and human security)

NATIONAL SECURITY POLICY

- What a government intends to achieve for its national security.
- The highest-level statement of a nation's values, vision and goals.



NATIONAL SECURITY STRATEGY

- Implementing national security policy
- A practical tool for coordination and planning: means, resources, division of labor.

<u>Pillar 2</u>: Measures to prevent and counter terrorism.


Pillar 4: Measures to ensure respect for human rights for all and the rule of law as the basis to counter terrorism
